2016 St. Ladislas AWE Survey



The following pages provide information regarding the St. Ladislas Church Survey conducted in Sept 2016. There were 684 responses to the survey.

Parishioners and Guests were asked to respond to a series of statements and to offer ways to improve the respective area. There were categories where parishioners elected not to respond. Some people elected to only identify their age or years of attendance at St. Ladislas.

83 people identified themselves as Guests in the Survey

The youngest person to respond was Age 5 and the oldest was Age 94.

Average Age of a St. Lads Parishioner is 58.1 years old. (based on the average of 684 responses)

The number of years in the Parish ranged from <1 year to 40 years. The average yrs of St. Lads participation was 17.35 years

- 351 people only circled numbers and made no remarks, therefore no additional feedback was provided
- 69 people made no comments but requested a copy
- 52 people made comments and requested copies
- 212 people made comments without requesting copies

Many comments were made about Fr. Snyder's Homilies and the positive impact on them.







2a. The Parish Leaders do an excellent job of communicating with me in regards to Activities and Events





2b. Parish Leaders do an excellent job of communicating with me in regards to Volunteer Activities











1 When I celebrate Liturgy here at St. Ladislas, I feel like I am part of a "warm" Community.

- We chose St. Lads because we were greeted warmly at the door
- Each of us should make an effort to welcome our brothers & sisters who are less outgoing before Mass & Donut Sundays
- We need to encourage ALL people to sing.
- we need more name tag Sundays
- I have seen a change in myself
- Get the people in the back to move to the front
- Stress all areas of God and cut back on people's wants
- More name tag Sundays or something similar
- Love name tag Sundays
- Need more Name Tag Sundays
- Add CYO Sports teams
- More youth Faith Building Events
- Depends on the parishioners at the Mass that day.
- Currently don't know what is going on except for the liturgical calendar.
- Any plans to mail the bulletin?
- Get kids more involved (Like Catholic Schools do)...
 - O While the children's choir is singing, we could have other children be ushers and lectors and have kids at the altar to greet the priest/deacon for the sign of peace
 - 'get some structure on kids grades 4-8 to get more involved in the church
 - Need more familiar hymns more often
 - More chairs with arms would be helpful
 - Keep on welcoming people
 - Smile and say Hello
 - Hard to improve because everyone is very accepting
 - Have a Youth Mass once a month
 - Everyone attends as a "stand alone " unit. Perhaps there might be a way to get better interaction.
 - There are too many narcistic people in Westlake and many of them live in this Parish
 - I appreciate the participation in songs and prayers of the congregation
 - Hard to answer this as most people at Mass are not "engaged" (don't participate)
 - Improve the Music ministry
 - Modernize or get some guitars to make music more of a celebration
 - At the Eucharist, we need to drop the 2 rows of ministers and have them surround the altar. It reminds me of the infantry.
 - I like the liveliness and the many ministers
 - I visited several parishes when I moved to this area and felt the "warmest" spiritual environment here at St. Lads
 - You don't know me
 - Share more information when stating your name during greeting before Mass
 - Sometimes people are friendly and other times they ignore my greeting when there is someone more "important" to talk to (this includes parish staff also)
 - Get some additional coat racks and have people take off coasts in winter
 - Need livelier music

- It would be better if there were more mention of the (community" activity /ministry in the prayers
- More fellowship and being more open to strangers
- Less singing

2A Parish Leaders do an excellent job of communicating with me in regards to Activities and Events

- Need more detailed communication regarding what the volunteer activity entails
- The bulletin has too many articles it should focus on relevant activities in our Parish
- More lead time in announcing special events
- Sometimes the same announcement is made several times at Mass. (commentator, deacon, leader)
- Need more youth Volunteers
- There are many choices

2B Parish Leaders do an excellent job of communicating with me in regards to Volunteer Activities

- Email notices of meetings so people can apply to the various groups
- A chart of vacancies/openings available in each ministry should be displayed somewhere
- I am new to this place, recently moved to Westlake.
- Proofread the bulletin before printing (or use spell check)
- I have heard that some who volunteer and not "called' or are a long list
- We signed up for volunteering twice and no one has contacted us.
- Too many people volunteer for things at the Fair and No one ever contacts them
- Too many volunteers and then not everybody can help then.
- Contact people who sign up for activities
- When someone volunteers....give that person an opportunity to be involved. Some groups are dominated by others.
- I wish I was back volunteering. (89 years young)
- We need to extend out into the community to non-Catholics religions.
- Need more activities for teens and families/couples in 30's and 40's
- Have the volunteer activities communicated more than once a year (Multiple fairs)
- Need more opportunities to volunteer as a family with young kids
- Have activities and events listed on the website
- Publish needed volunteers in the bulletin.
- Clean up the bulletin. It is too busy. Have one column for activities, one for volunteer opportunities in same place each week.
- Too many people sign up and then you don't get to help
- Let families know how to sign up to take up the offertory
- Provide more information on options to volunteer
- I did not get contacted after volunteering
- Sometimes there is conflict of information between pre-Mass announcements, bulletins and mailings (lot better these days)
- Maybe more interesting 50+ events in the evening. (written by a 75 yr old)
- Weekly explanation of activities (1 or 2 a week) in the bulletin
- Not all activities and events have enough information provided
- Not sure I know all of the volunteer opportunities. The yearly ministry fair is good. Perhaps a weekly article in the bulletin about a ministry (not an individual) would help
- It seems very clickishat St. Lads
- Get children more involved
- I am personally limited to volunteering because of poor health
- Need to offer the volunteering event 2 times per year
- Send out some personal invitations
- Get personal invitations from members and not just from the leaders
- I really need service hours (age unknown)
- Too many errors in the bulletin
- A list given out annually of all the opportunities available email special needs
- Need more than one parish fair
- Do not fill in your name as EM if it is not your month to do this. At the 11 A.M. Mass, people assigned feel not needed

- Would love to know more about children's activities (age 6)
- Keep asking individuals to participate
- Advertise specific jobs within groups. (rather than simple invites to become active)

3 I feel like I belong here at St. Ladislas Parish

- Have parishioners reach out to new people (visitors and parishioners)
- Have the parish call each Parish family once a month
- It is not the fault of the parish. My husband has altzheimers and dementia and relates to old parish...and therefore can't get that involved at this time.
- I feel very strongly involved in the Catholic Church because of the Eucharist
- Welcomed warmly but wish there were opportunities to meet single people. Have no family here.
- Need more gatherings and more speakers
- I need to get more involved
- Can more be done in include people with special needs----areas to volunteer..social
- We have nice greeters
- Sometimes greeters don't seem to be in place prior to Mass
- Sometimes the congregation and ministries feel cliquey.
- Weekday liturgy is beautiful.
- The Cantors need improvement on weekends
- Organ music is joyful
- I am a new parishioner and getting more and more acclimated
- One Mass at another church was outside and that was a great testimony for others to see us worship
- Sometimes, when the people at mass and staff are friendly, but other times they are not
- Keep politics out of petitions, homilies etc. We are not evangelical "Christian" we are Catholics
- I have rated this a "9". It is really up to me to make this a "10"

4 I am warmly greeted when I celebrate Liturgy here at St. Ladislas Parish

- Now I know more people because of joining and reaching out. (Wasn't until I made connections)
- Some of the ushers are less enthusiastic than others (not necessarily the younger ones!) ...and please have a dress code
- "Bolster" greeters view of what they do and how important that simple hello is
- More name tag Sundays. It gives people comfort in saying hello when they might not do it otherwise
- 11 A.M. Sunday is our usual Mass. We know many and they know us.
- We need more interaction.
- Most of the time, but not always.'
- Some greeters are not as friendly
- Greeters need to be more friendly
- Some greeters are friendly, some are not. Some stand and talk to each other the whole time and ignore people walking in
- Greeters could smile more
- Need greeters at the door with a smile and say "Hello"
- Sometimes greeters do not greet me
- All parishioners should be welcomed
- Greeters need to be more outgoing and helpful to find seats
- Train greeters on smiling and being warm as we enter. Dissuade unhappy people from being greeters
- Greeters aren't always at liturgies –sometimes they are talking to each other.—they need training
- Not all ushers greet people as they come into church. Ushers need to be trained as greeters.

- Greeters at entrance is not a necessity for me as were are greeted once Mass starts
- I feel an excellent opportunity to greet others at mass as led by the Parish Leaders
- One church we visited had a time set aside before church for parishioners to share some needing prayers (46 yr old)
- Follow Psalms in the book
- Weekday Masses are not as welcoming
- Have heard from GUESTS that they feel welcome

5 I have the opportunity to share my gifts of time, talent, expertise and wisdom here at St. Ladislas.

- Speakers at Masses need to communicate different groups to join
- Attempt to engage younger people (20-30)....Perhaps catch the during Good Shepherd programs, First Communion Programs etc.
- I am not significantly involved, but that is my fault
- Perhaps a questionnaire that asks what talents or strengths a person can contribute (or not), but to be available if needed. (teacher, musician, business contacts, baking)...especially encourage mid age and younger persons. There are talented people we have not "touched' or tapped into. What can they bring to the Lord's table?
- Need more outreach to parishioners like home visits by fellow parishioners to ask people to give their gifts to Parish.
- Need more youth activities
- Need more kids jobs
- Everyone has the opportunity to volunteer.
- Expertise and wisdom can be shared "in committee" depending upon the group leaders. Father Don and Bob Hertl welcome any ideas, even ones that challenge.
- Too many groups run by the same dominant people
- Have tried to join some groups, but they seem to be controlled by "cliques" who don't welcome new members and want to stay in "control"
- Feel I would if parish was based on homily and bulletin
- I have filled out a ministry form twice now and have only been contact by one ministry
- I signed up for several groups/activities on a "Welcome" Sunday and I never heard from any of them
- The activities are well done. It makes you want to be part of something that meets the high expectations of the organizers and planners. The time you spend is participating is fulfilling, positive and productive to the people of that activity.
- I am still working
- I have not been reached out to
- Maybe have an outreach night where people come and pray to explore their gifts and then sign up or Mentor in a ministry to see if it is for them
- When one person does multiple jobs at a liturgy, it appears that there is no need for anyone else (67 yr old input)
- I can volunteer in 2 years after my boys go off to college. Right now we travel a lot.
- Some older committees that are long established are not open to new ideas and suggestions
- There are opportunities in some places, but others have people involved that oppose change and it does not feel as inviting and so people don't come after a while because new ideas are not "welcomed"
- I wish they would give Communion in small paper cups as I get cold sores. Also people have colds drinking out of gold chalices. (85 yr old)
- We are failing to ask what people would like to do. We are just asking about our need.

• More announcements needed from the pulpit about events so that we get more participation

- Need more Fathers Phoners
- More information in bulletin, internet and phone
- Lack of follow up after signing up for a specific group
- Need more personal invitations
- We need to invite those we don't see often new and younger people
- There are not enough events for younger kids (age 13)
- If "personally" includes email, then I agree
- Perhaps a phone call to members who have been in attendance
- Do a calendar for the full year and send out in January

7 Would you recommend St. Ladislas to your family and/or friends?

- Encourage new move Ins (neighborhoods)....When I moved into Westlake in 2009, 3 people from Protestant Church came with cookies and information about their choir, etc. We should copy this idea.
- We have recommended St. Lads and several have joined our Parish.
- More announcements needed from the pulpit about events so that we get more participation
- Love Father Don and his messages
- I would recommend Catholicism to anyone because of its universality.
- We have a family member who came back after 25 years.
- Need the Tabernacle at least in a better view.
- More inspiring stations of the cross
- The music does not engage us. It is slow, out-of-date and often non-musical.
- I have made copies of the Streaming of the Sunday Mass to send to family and friends
- I always recommend St. Lads to family and friends
- Music needs to be improved
- Sermons are excellent
- I have invited friends to attend weekend liturgies and they keep coming (remark from a 65 Yr old)
- The music/organ is sometimes tough to listen to
- Opportunity for others to hear Fr. Don's homilies.
- Send invite (nicely done) to people in the area for a special Mass—Might get more to attend
- New wine, new skins

- The Blessed Mother is honored at this Church
- The Good Shepherd Program has been wonderful for my family
- Donut Sundays are always a hit with kids and gives parents an opportunity to get together with others—this builds community
- We just relocated to this area and are visiting all the Catholic Churches to find the right one to join
- 50+ Group should consider holding activities in the evening after 5 P.M. so those that work can get involved
- Why do we sit during communion before the consecrated host is put away?
- Pastor could personally welcome new people after Mass on their way out.
- It is very obvious that everyone is happy at St. Lads. Happy to be a member of this great parish. Truly a family of love and receivers of wonderful messages.

- We are registered members of another parish, but for personal reasons we attend St. Lads occasionally and always feel welcome here.
- I tell everyone how I feel and how wonderful our parish is
- If possible, some type of instruction for teens on the reality of the Eucharist being the actually body and blood of Jesus to help them and strengthen them when their faith is challenged in college
- Father Snyder and others give excellent sermons.
- Thrust of parish is positive and toward improvement.
- Wish I had time to participate more. First Parish I joined because I liked it so much.
- This parish is very warm and welcoming. Sermons Inspire. Father Snyder is awesome. I love it here!
- Recycle after Parish events. Use recycled items. Use products that can be recycled.
- I think we should do more adult education and offer some courses on parenting for young families
- You need drums in the Music
- Music needs to improve.
- The liturgies don't feel like a celebration! Sometimes we just go through the motions. (comment from a 71 yr old)
- God Bless Father Don and Sister Johnica. Father Don always provides an amazing sermon.
- My wife loves Fr. Snyder's sermons
- I would like to hear and see more study and explanation of the Bible during Mass.
- I would like to see programs advertizing contemporary Catholic/Christian/Presentation Issues.
- I would like to see Fr. Charles Curran presentation on the Joy of Love -? Conscience which he presented in Cleveland 9/22.
- Parish has a wonderful warmness. Fr. Snyder's homilies are outstanding.
- Relationships with the Support of St. Ignatius is great work.
- I need to join St. Lads. Just moved to the area. I am used to a more traditional church.
- Parish staff is excellent (except for spelling in the bulletin) I used to work as a proofreader. I would be glad to volunteer as a proofreader (Rezabek)
- Father Don is great.
- Father Don's homilies are great.
- Return to the old Gloria
- Regarding Best Friends here.....not why I come , but a good thing
- Emulate Deacon John's reading method.....He's not theatrical, he reads clearly and well
- Thank you for being here and for my family
- I could not imagine a better parish to have grown old in
- We don't attend Mass enough mostly due to our schedule
- Find new ways to bring the WAY group to participate and get younger members into the liturgy. Have a Youth Mass where they are the EM's, readers etc. Get them involved beyond their own meetings. (65 yr comments)
- I believe that the EM's should be "re-trained" every year here in this parish to remind them that "eye contact" and a smile would be beneficial. A server at Bob Evans knows the importance of a smile. The EM's are serving the Best Bread in town.
- As a lector, I would like Bob Hertl or Fr. Don to conduct a "refresher" meeting where we are encouraged and critiqued (positively of course) and to remind us that we are not reading a "boring" announcement or proclamation.
- This is a wonderful parish and the best since I have participated since Childhood.
- Pastor Fr. Don is the absolute best.
- I am not your traditional Roman Catholic. I believe in birth control and marriage equality, but I still feel welcome here at St. Lads.
- We have children and we like the Good Shepherd Program.
- My wife and I moved to St. Lads in 2000 after being at St. Bernadette for 12 years and one other parish all my life. We did shop around, and found our place here at St. Lads.
- I like our parish and Father Don.
- I find St. Lads a warm and welcoming Parish. We have strong ties to our former parish due to a large support group. We go to Mass at St. Lads and like it a lot, but I don't have much time to be involved.

- I feel very connected to the gospel in my daily life. My family visits from outside the country. I very much enjoy our services and the homilies.

- Would appreciate more contemporary music during the liturgy
- My husband and I moved here 4 years ago from PA. We feel so very welcome and love everything about this Church
- Music needed to be updated and improve
- Need to reach out to include youth/teens in the liturgy
- I enjoy the Mass here and the homilies
- St. Lads is my alternative to my home parish of St. Clarence
- We have come from another parish, but we feel more comfortable with the community here at St Lads. I find it
 remarkable that my non-Catholic husband is comfortable here, so we are attending Mass much more regularly as a whole
 family.

- I am not a parishioner, but wish I could do it too. (anonymous)
- A Sunday evening Mass would be wonderful. (5 P.M. or 5:30 P.M.)
- Good Shepherd Program and Sacrament preparation (reconciliation for First Communion is fantastic)

- Amazing church, but I feel like the 9-12 Good Shepherd program could be tweaked a little bit. I feel like the time was too early, because school exits at 3:30, I get home at 3:45, and I leave at 3:50. There is hardly any time for me to relax in between, but I think the program is great.
- Would love to have tabernacle on altar with lighted candle as Bishop wanted
- Always enjoy and get so much out of Fathers talks and homilies so I come when able to Mass.
- Please stop doing Name Tag Sundays....it is phony and non effective.
- Change 50+ Club to a 50+ up to 65, and then another club from 65+. 50 year olds have more different activity levels than the average age of the current 50+ club. (57 yr old parishioner)
- This is the first parish where I feel a sense of Community
- No activities in this parish for single adults
- St. Lads needs a teen Mass also a teen/young adult mass Band/choir (author unknown)
- The challenge is to begin engaging our children, high school students and young adults
- Additional Saturday Mass around 6:30 to 7 P.M.
- People do have the opportunity to be involved in this parish
- My ancestors were married, baptized and attended St. Lads
- Please consider exposition of the Blessed Sacrament as a group experience for the children
- I don't feel very comfortable here at St. Lad's and I probably will be moving back to my home parish in the next year. You did do something very good though when you started streaming the Mass on the internet. That is a very positive step in the right direction toward inclusion of the homebound and people in the nursing homes (author unknown)
- We occasionally attend worship at Bay Presbyterian (BPC) and truly enjoy the longer and more informative educational sermons. I think many of the Catholics attending BPC (and there are a lot) came for that reason. I thought Bishops Quinn's style of preaching spoke to that need. I am not being a critic of Fr. Don, but just saying the BPC style is preferred. It saddens me to see that Mass at any time being 50% full. The homily needs to provide more instruction, Biblical Foundation, Inspiration and thought provoking info. Go to the BPC website and listen to the 8/20/16 sermon by church member and former missionary John Murtha and you will see what I am talking about.
- I find Father Snyder inspiring. I love his sermons, his attitude, and his leadership. Deeply wish you had a "quiet Mass" which is one with just entrance hymn, communion hymn and closing. Sometimes all the singing of everything is overwhelming, especially since I can't sing.
- Love Fr. Don. He gives the best homilies. We are blessed to have him. Deacon Dennis gives good homilies on Friday mornings.
- · Celebration of the liturgy is prayerful and invites participation from the community. Homilies are excellent
- This is my Mom's Parish...I should be at St. Bernadette (Guest)
- I would love to have more newer hymns. I don't see young people singing.
