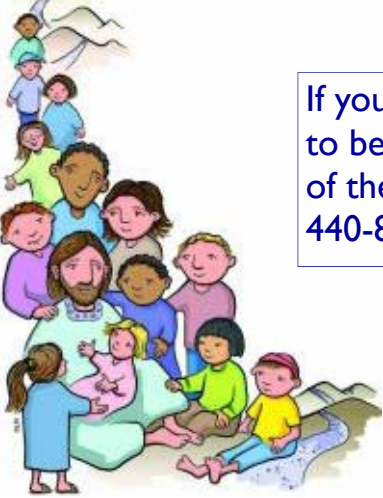


Ask your child what we talked about today!

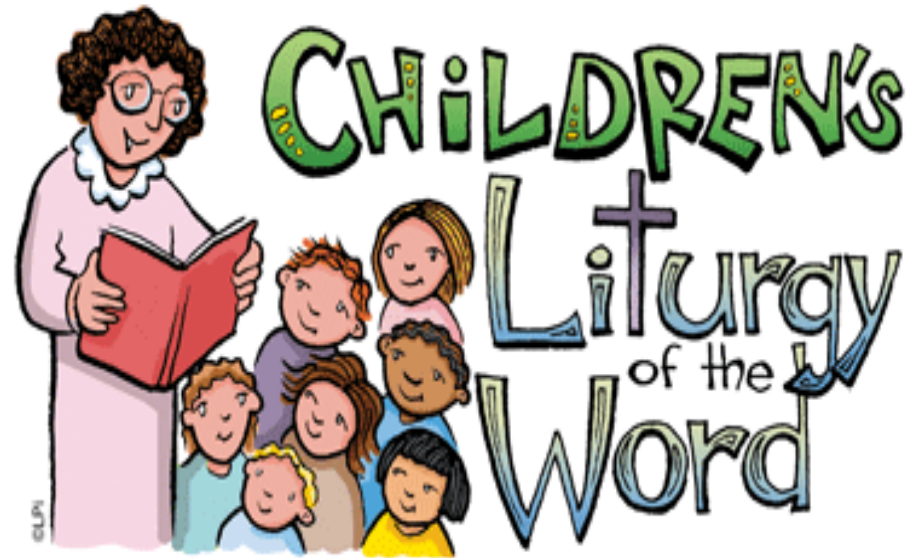
The children's Liturgy is a way of helping our children understand the ritual of our Sunday Liturgy as the primary experience of Catholic Christians.

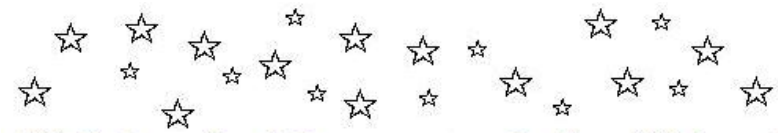
